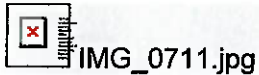

ADIRONDACK LAKE DAM – The Town is in the process of mailing out letters to Weed District taxpayers advising that the dam construction project is expected to begin at the end of March with a tentative completion date of September 2025. Byron Park and the Pavilion will be shut down until the dam is complete. The Town will not be working on bog removal as the lake will be lowered 8 to 10 inches. A copy of the Town letter is attached.

LAKE GEORGE/LAKE CHAMPLAIN REGIONAL PLANNING BOARD – Contact has been made with this Board and the WAB is waiting to hear from the Board to schedule a meeting as to assistance that may be available regarding lake management.

PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE TRAINING – The Nature Conservancy has agreed to provide a presentation/training to interested persons regarding the identification and removal of purple loosestrife, an invasive species, that has been identified as being present in Adirondack Lake. Considering the recently announced dam construction, the WAB would still like to proceed with and schedule training in mid-August or shortly thereafter. The WAB will see if that can be done with the ongoing construction and lower lake water level.
